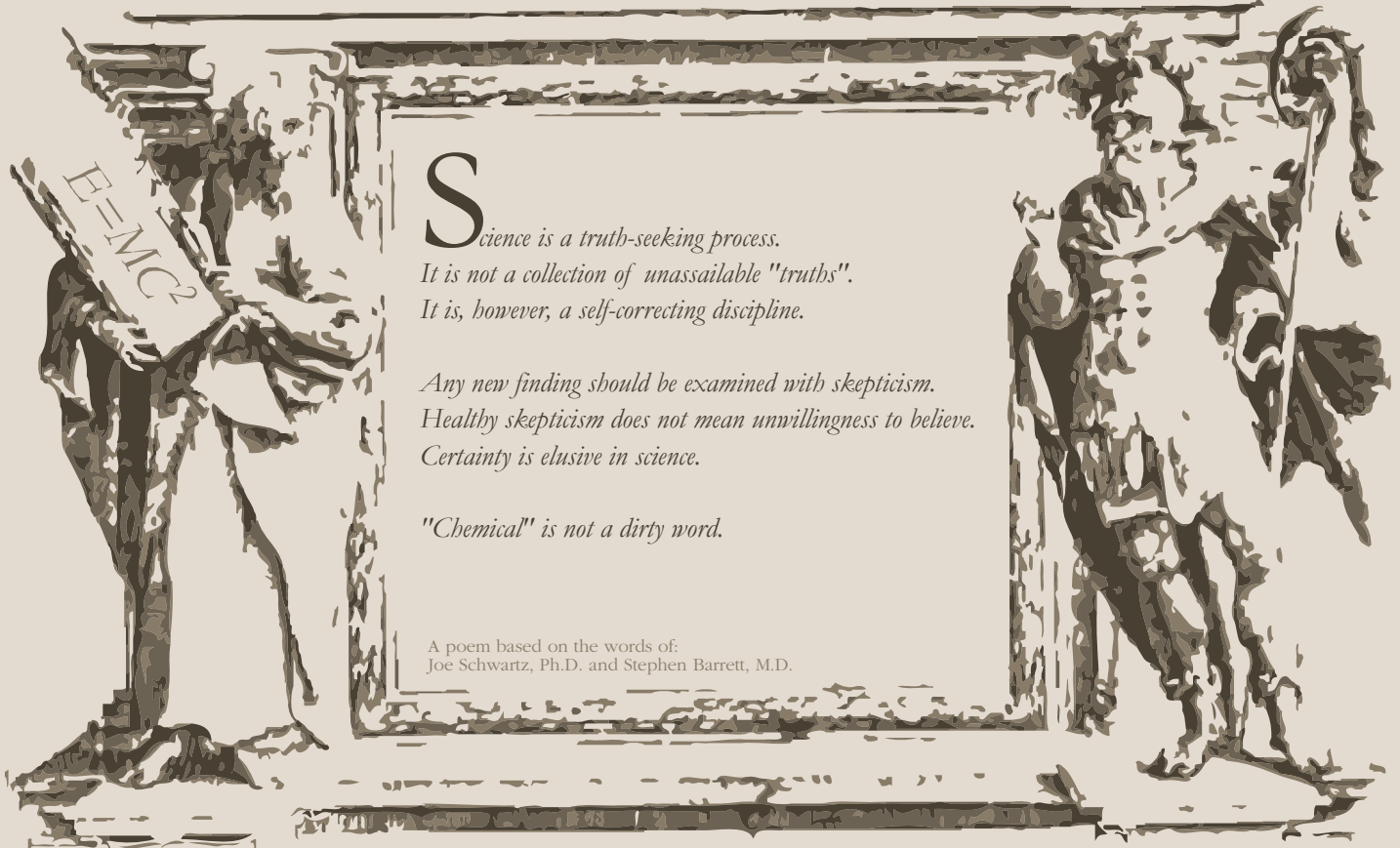


Science
